To ensure the mix of students essential to Lavelle Prep's success, separate lotteries will be conducted for Special Education and General Education students. Incoming sixth and seventh grade students are selected through a lottery, in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act. All applicants not immediately selected will be added to a waiting list.



Eligibility, Application & Deadline

- Applications must be received by midnight on **April 2nd** to be included in the lottery
- All children residing in New York State are eligible to attend Lavelle Prep
- Preferences will be given to siblings of current Lavelle Prep students
- Preferences will be given for students residing in CSD 31 (Staten Island)
- To qualify for Special Education lottery, student must have current Individualized Education Plan (IEP)
- A separate application must be completed for each child
- Parents/guardians will be notified of acceptance at the lottery drawing on April 23, 2018, and posted on our website by May 1, 2018
- Please complete, sign, and return this application by mail or fax to **Lavelle Prep at Corporate Commons One at 1 Teleport Drive, Floor 3, Staten Island, NY 10311**
- Applicants not immediately selected will be added to a waiting list
