Dear Parents/Guardians,

In an effort to provide our students with more options and expressive freedom in regard to what they wear, our High School team has decided to implement more colors and clothing options into the school uniform policy.

The following updated uniform policy will be in effect immediately:

Students can wear

Polo shirts: Green, Grey, Orange, White

Pants/Shorts/Skirts: Navy Blue, Khaki, **Black***

Green Fleece Zip-ups

Lavelle Sponsored T-Shirts including a Lavelle logo:

Green, Grey, Orange, White, Black, Navy Blue

The website to purchase these t-shirts will be shared with you once finalized.

Hoodies and Outerwear: Green, Grey, Orange, White, Black, Navy Blue

(Outerwear must be mono colored. Outerwear with no logo is **heavily preferred**, but front logos coverable by the palm of the student's hand will be acceptable.

Students may **not** wear hats, bandanas, silkies, or any other head coverings not related to religious expression.

Students also still may **not** wear sweats, jeans, or leggings, regardless of color.

A few precautions have been put into place in order to ensure that all students are in proper uniform on a daily basis. Parent/guardian will be called if the student is not in uniform and will be advised to bring the set of clothes for students to change.

- The first out of uniform infraction will result in an in-school lunch time reflection.
- The second will result in an after-school detention.
